

➢ GROUPS OF MINES 561,800 sqm (plus newly discovered suspect hazardous areas) in Bujanovac

 CLUSTER MUNITIONS around 1 000 000 sqm (Tutin, Bujanovac, Užice)

> UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE (UXO) ON LAND around 18 500 000 sqm (Kraljevo, Vranje, Novi Pazar, Leskovac, Kragujevac)

> AIR BOMBS – ROCKETS around 150 DIFFERENT SUSPECTED LOCATIONS ON LAND

SUNKEN GERMAN FLEET (WWII) NEAR PRAHOVO PORT

> UNDER WATER UXO-12 DIFFERENT SUSPECTED LOCATIONS ON SAVA RIVER AND DANUBE RIVER

PROGRESS MADE DURING THE PREVIOUS EXTENSION REQUEST 2018 -2022

2018

5 projects were implemented resulting in the clearance of 623,020 square metres in 2018 in the Municipality of Bujanovac. The funds for 4 projects have been donated, through ITF Enhancing Human Security, by the US and the Republic of Korea. For one project, funds have been provided by the Republic of Serbia and matched through ITF with the US donation and the donation by the Republic of Korea

2019

3 projects were implemented in the Municipality of Bujanovac, addressing a total area of 606.210 square metres. The funds for one project were provided by the Serbian Government which were matched, through ITF, by the US donation and the donation of the Republic of Korea. One project was funded by Japan, with the support of the U.S., through ITF. One project was financed by the Joint Stock Company "Elektromreža Srbije" - Transmission System Maintenance Division, Belgrade.

2020

1 project was implemented in the Municipality of Bujanovac, total area of 269.280 sqm. The funds for the project were provided by the Serbian Government which were matched, through ITF, by the US donation.


2021

1 project was implemented in the Municipality of Bujanovac, total area of 294.230 square metres. The funds for the project were provided by the Serbian Government which were matched, through ITF, by the US donation and the donation by the Republic of Korea.

REMAINING MINE CONTAMINATION IN SERBIA



- > OTTAWA CONVENTION OBLIGATIONS OF SERBIA (MARCH 2023 DEADLINE)
- IN MARCH 2022, SERBIA SUBMITTED AN EXTENSION REQUEST FOR THE PERIOD 2023-2025
- GROUPS OF MINES CONTAMINATING AREA OF 561,800 SQM IN THE BUJANOVAC MUNICIPALITY PLUS NEWLY IDENTIFIED SUSPECT HAZARDOUS AREAS
 - > No mine emplacement records
 - Inaccessible terrain during some periods of year

MOSTLY HILLY AND MOUNTAINOUS TERRAIN OF IMPORTANCE TO CIVILIANS CONCERNING

- Safety
- > Cattle breeding
- Exploitation of woods
- Mushroom picking
- Tobacco production

✓ SHA AND CHA VISIBLY MARKED WITH "STOP UXO" SIGNS IN SERBIAN AND ALBANIAN LANGUAGE



Unregistered mine contaminated areas (groups of mines): The remaining mine contaminated areas do not have registries and have not been planted in specific patterns, which aggravates demining efforts, namely survey results are subject to alterations (increase of SHA).

Climactic conditions: Contaminated areas are inaccessible during some periods of the year causing operation delays; most of the suspected area is not appropriate for the use of mine detection dogs or machinery.

Newly identified mine suspected areas discovered during forest fires in Bujanovac, in October 2019 and in August 2021.







Finding of donor funds: due to COVID and redirection of funds for cluster munitions clearance and UXO clearance, funds for mine clearance have been reduced.









Contamination other than mines: Unexploded cluster munitions, air bombs – rockets and other UXO on land and underwater

> -Priority given to: residential buildings, ski paths, airport runway, electricity transmission network, factories

 (FUNDS PROVIDED BY SERBIA AND MATCHED THROUGH ITF WITH U.S. AND REPUBLIC OF KOREA DONATIONS)

NON-TECHNICAL SURVEY PROJECT FOR NEWLY IDENTIFIED SHA DEVELOPED AND WILL BE CARRIED OUT IN <u>2022-2023</u> (IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH ITF TO FINDING THE DONORS FUNDS)

>FUNDS NEEDED FOR THE PERIOD 2022-2025 ~3.040.000 EUR

BENEFITS OF DEMINING





- Demining has contributed and will contribute to the safety of local population.
- Conditions for safe exploitation of forest, development of cattle breeding and picking of mushrooms will be created.
- Safe and stable electricity supply will be provided.
- Improvement of interethnic relations in a multi-ethnic environment such as the Municipality of Bujanovac (Serbs, Albanians, Roma)
- Environment protection and protection against fire will be significantly increased.
- Given that the Bujanovac Municipality is the most underdeveloped municipality in Serbia, for the purpose of its development and prevention of migration of its inhabitants due to economic reasons, demining will enable implementation of development projects, such as for example construction of solar plants, development of wood industry, namely exploitation and processing of wood.
- MINE FREE SERBIA BY 2025 achievement of a universal goal, significance for the South East Europe region
